**Call to Order:** President Gollmer called the Special Meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. President Gollmer announced the meeting was being audio recorded.

**Appointed Officials Attending:** Edward Betza/Solicitor, Stacy L. Kibler/Borough Secretary, Jeffery Parker/Patrolman and Lynn Rublee/Streets Crew.

**Visitors Attending:** Rex and Alice Jackson.

**Road Salt:** Christopher Byers motioned, Ginger Cinti seconded to participate in the Department of General Services statewide contract for road salt in 2019 -2020. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Lakeside Drive:** Council agreed the Lakeside Drive Cul-De-Sac will be plowed counter clockwise leaving the snow in the middle of the cul-de-sac. The snow will be moved at later date if necessary.

**Recess:** President Gollmer recessed the meeting at 7:11 p.m. for an executive session for personnel matters.

**Reconvened:** President Gollmer reconvened the meeting at 8:08 p.m.

**Employment:** Christopher Byers motioned, Karen Watson seconded, to advertise for a working supervisor for the streets department. All agreed. Motioned carried.

**Streets Employees:** The streets employees will be supervised by the streets committee until a supervisor is hired.

Christopher Byers motioned, Paul Nervo seconded, to advertise for a part-time water and sewer operator. All agreed motion carried.

**Police Contract:** Douglas Straw motioned, Paul Nervo seconded, to accept the Borough's Proposal for the 2019-2024 police contract. All agreed except Ginger Cinti. Motion carried. The new contract will include a three percent wage increase each year, officers will contribute \$10 per week, as an individual, to the health insurance, and \$20 per week, as an employee with dependents, and the borough will pay 50% of post retirement health insurance capped at \$4,000 per year.
