- Reviewed the Walnut Grove Condominium map forward from Stacy Kibler, and it sets forth no additional information regarding the location of utility easements, including an easement for sanitary sewer lines, reserved in the Walnut Grove Condominium Declaration. Consultation and coordination between the contractor, engineer and Condominium Association and unit owners is recommended prior to commencement of construction.
- I drafted an ordinance requiring property owners, who are required to connect to the sanitary sewer system and who are not connected, to pay a sewage capacity reservation fee until the connection is made.
- The reservation of capacity fee for property owners of a single-family residence is 60% of the prior year's annual average sewage usage charge for residential customers in the Borough, and for property owners who own a property other than a single-family residence the fee is 60% of the rate they would otherwise be paying if connected.
- I have consulted with Engineer Halmi on the draft ordinance and will forward it to Solicitor Betza for his review and comment.

The reservation of capacity charge is required to be "based on debt and fixed operating expenses."
