**Call to Order:** President Gollmer called the meeting to order at 6:58 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Roll Call:** Christopher G. Byers, Ginger L. Cinti, Thomas Eberle, Mary G. Gollmer, Paul Orr, Joshua Sturgeon, Alan J. Watkins, and Mayor Andrew J. Graves were present.

**Appointed Officials Attending:** Edward J. Betza/Solicitor, and Stacy L. Kibler/Borough Secretary.

**Visitors Attending:** Julia Brink, Gregg Mitcho, Ron Rogers, and Marvin Waxham.

**Minutes:** Christopher Byers motioned, Thomas Eberle seconded, to approve the March 11, 2024, Minutes, as presented. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Bills for approval:** Christopher Byers motioned, Paul Orr seconded, to approve the April bills, and ratification. All agreed. Motion carried.

Christopher Byers motioned, Ginger Cinti seconded, to approve payroll ratifications. All agreed, except Alan Watkins, who abstained because of a personal conflict. Motion carried.

**Fire Company Account:** Ginger Cinti motioned, Christopher Byers seconded, to open a new account with PLGIT for fire tax revenue. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Paving Project:** Christopher Byers motioned, Paul Orr seconded, to advertise the 2024 street paving project. All agreed. Motion carried. The 2024 paving project will include the entire length of Southpark Drive, Smith Street from Fall Drive to 9871 Smith Street, the intersection of Smith and Chestnut Streets. It will also include an alternative for Maple Avenue from Elk Street to Hall Avenue.

**Elk Creek Rec and Leisure Board:** Ginger Cinti motioned, Thomas Eberle seconded, to appoint Rhonda Nicholes and Donna Miller as the Lake City Borough representatives on the Elk Creek Recreation and Leisure Board. All approved. Motioned carried.

**County Aid Resolution:** Christopher Byers motioned, Thomas Ebele seconded, to approve the County Aid Resolution. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Generator:** Paul Orr motioned, Christopher Byers seconded, to allow Paul Orr to look at the generator Millcreek Township has for sale. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Locator:** Alan Watkins motioned, Thomas Eberle seconded, to purchase the radio detection locator from Eastcom. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Sewer Jetter:** Alan Watkins motioned, Christopher Byers seconded, to purchase a warthog nozzle from Golden Equipment. All agreed, except Joshua Sturgeon. Motion carried.

**Agenda Amendment:** Christopher motioned, Paul Orr seconded, to amend the agenda to include the easement at York Seaway. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Easement:** Rick York, owner of York-Seaway, is requesting Council remove an easement from his property. The easement was established for water wells and lines. Council requested more information on the easement prior to deciding.

**Julia Brink:** of 551 Lakeside Drive, appeared to request information on funding for installing a new furnace. Council informed Julia LIHEAP or National Fuel may have programs to help. The neighbor has an outdoor burner which is causing her husband to have health problems. Julia requested an update on the court case with the neighbor, and Council requested Officer Henneberry to give her an update.
