Minutes: Stacy Lesnett motioned, and Ginger Cinti seconded, to approve the July 14, 2025, minutes as presented. All agreed. Motion carried.

Street Foreman: Council requested to speak with the Street Foreman either this Wednesday or Friday. The Foreman could adjust his work schedule to eliminate any down time.

Fingerprint System: Stacy Lesnett motioned, Ginger Cinti seconded, to hire an IT company to repair the fingerprint system on the time clock. All agreed, except Alan Watkins. Motion carried.
