Minutes: Samatha Luper motioned, and Karyn Santry seconded, to approve the January 12 and January 26, 2026, minutes, amending the January 12th minutes to remove the sentence "Council said the Foreman did a great job." All agreed. Motion carried.

Bills for approval: Karyn Santry motioned, and Megan Smith seconded, to approve the February bills and ratifications. All agreed. Motion carried.

Code Book Update: Samantha Luper motioned, Kaylee Orr seconded, to accept the quote from General Code to update the codifications. All agreed. Motion carried.

Tablet: Karyn Santry motioned, and Kaylee Orr seconded, to purchase a Samsung Galaxy tablet for \$749.00. All agreed. Motion carried.

Handicap Ramps: Karyn Santry motioned, and Megan Smith seconded, to request bids for the handicap ramps. All agreed. The motion carried.

Animal Ordinance: Kaylee Orr motioned, and Karyn Santry seconded, to advertise the public hearing for the animal ordinance amendment with a thirty-day enactment period. All agreed except Ginger Cinti. Motion carried.

Time Clocks: Council requested the Borough Secretary to determine if the time clock app will let you clock in once you are within Wi-Fi range, and how the camera system on the time clock works.

Salt Participation: Joshua Sturgeon motioned, Samantha A. Luper seconded, to participate in the statewide salt contract. All agreed. Motion carried.

Safe Procedures and Reporting: Council requested all employees be sent for a drug and alcohol screen, and to a physician for all injuries. An email report will be sent to Council for injuries and property damage.

Call-Ins: Joshua Sturgeon motioned, Kaylee Orr seconded, to mandate two employees to be call-in for all call-ins. All agreed. The motion carried.

Police Contract: Paul Orr appointed Samantha Luper, Kaylee Orr, and Karyn Santry to the police negotiation committee.
