Call to Order: President Gollmer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Ginger L. Cinti, Christopher G. Byers, Thomas Eberle, Raymond H. Fisher, Mary G. Gollmer, Jenny L. Potter, Alan J. Watkins, and Mayor Andrew J. Graves were present.

Appointed Officials Attending: Edward J. Betza /Solicitor, Stacy L. Kibler/Borough Secretary, Troy Stainbrook/Assistant Operator, and David Wierzchowski/Police Chief.

Visitors Attending: Ellen Avlon, Juston Cannon, and Gregg Mitcho.

Minutes: Thomas Eberle motioned, Jenny Potter seconded, to approve the June 13, 2022, Minutes. All agreed. Motion carried.

Bills for Approval: Christopher Byers motioned, Thomas Eberle seconded, to approve the June Bills and Bill Ratifications. All agreed, except Ginger Cinti. Motion carried.

Payroll Ratifications: Jenny Potter motioned, Christopher Byers seconded, to approve the payroll ratifications. All agreed, except Alan Watkins, who abstained, for a personal conflict. Motion carried.

2017 Ford Interceptor: Thomas Eberle motioned, Ginger Cinti seconded, to accept Christopher Byers bid for Ford Explorer Police Interceptor, in the amount of \$7,643.36. All agreed, except Christopher Byers, who abstained, and Alan Watkins voted no. Motion carried.

Lake City Fire Company: Juston Cannon, President of Lake City Fire Company, approached Council about providing fuel to the West County Paramedics until Fairview Fire Company fuel system is repaired. Thomas Eberle motioned, Jenny Potter seconded, for the solicitor to prepare an agreement to sell fuel to the West County Paramedics with 3% administrative fee, and the agreement will be review monthly. The motion was voted down.

Christopher Byers motioned, Alan Watkins seconded, for the solicitor to prepare an agreement to sell fuel to the West County Paramedics at the Boroughs Cost, and the agreement will be reviewed review monthly. All agreed. Motion carried.

President Cannon also reported the Firemen's Carnival had a good turnout. Gear lost in a fire will be covered by insurance.

Street Sweeper: Golden Equipment submitted a bid under the co-star's contract for 2023 International Tymco 600 Street Sweeper, in the amount of \$307,380.00. Thomas Eberle motioned, Alan Watkins seconded, to accept the bid. All agreed. Motion carried.

Airborn: is considering installing a humidity control system for their entire facility. They are requesting a rate adjustment on their sewer bill. The new system would use an additional 168,750 gallons of water per year with 90% of the water evaporating and not enter the sewer system. Council requested more information for the next meeting.

Juneteenth: Council did not take action on including Juneteenth as holiday for the employees.

Paint Sprayer: Christopher Byers motioned, Alan Watkins seconded, to rent a paint sprayer after checking with the Girard School District Superintendent. All agreed. Motion carried.

Adjourned: President Gollmer adjourned the meeting at 8:05 p.m.
