Call to Order: President Byers called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitors Attending: None

Recess: President Byers recessed the meeting to an executive session at 6:20 p.m. for the police contract.

Reconvened: President Byers reconvened the meeting at 6:28 p.m.

Street Employee: Paul Orr motioned, Ginger Cinti seconded, to advertise for a union foreman. All agreed except Thomas Eberle and Alan Watkins. Motion carried. The job posting will be posted internally prior to advertising to the public.

Paul Orr motioned, Joshua Sturgeon seconded, to pay the union managerial position \$52,000 a year. All agreed except Thomas Eberle and Alan Watkins. Motion carried.

Police Contract: Thomas Eberle motioned, Paul Orr seconded, to accept the 2024-2026 police agreement with a \$20 per week health insurance contribution. Christopher Byers, Ginger Cinti, and Alan Watkins voted no, and Thomas Eberle, Paul Orr, and Joshua Sturgeon voted yes. Motion carried after Andrew Graves broke the tie.

LSA Resolutions: Thomas Eberle motioned, Joshua Sturgeon seconded, to accept the revised resolutions to apply for LSA grant funding for a police interceptor, a high-pressure sewer jetter, and a backhoe loader. All agreed. Motion carried.

Adjourned: Christopher Byers adjourned the meeting at 6:38 p.m.
