Call to Order: President Byers called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chief Wierzchowski recorded the meeting.

Roll Call: Christopher G. Byers, Ginger L. Cinti, Thomas Eberle, Stacy L. Lesnett, Paul Orr, Joshua Sturgeon, Alan J. Watkins, and Mayor Andrew J. Graves were present.

Patty Gresh of 2356 Elk Street stated her sidewalks have been damaged during the construction of the Elk Street Water Line Project and are not slated to be fixed. Patty presented Council with photos of the sidewalks. Council informed Patty the contractor was scheduled to finish the project within the next week.

Christopher Felegie of 2342 Elk Street thought the contractors did a good job but hoped all the damaged sidewalks would be repaired.

Minutes: Thomas Eberle motioned, and Paul Orr seconded, to approve September 8 and 22, 2025, minutes as presented. All agreed. Motion carried.

Bills for approval: Paul Orr motioned, Thomas Eberle seconded, to approve the October bills, bill and Payroll ratifications. All agreed except Alan Watkins who abstained. The motion carried.

Transfer Resolution: Ginger Cinti motioned, Stacy Lesnett seconded, to accept the transfer resolutions. All agreed. Motion carried. The resolutions are attached as part of these minutes.

Old Lake Road: Thomas Eberle motioned, Paul Orr seconded, to pave a 20' x 50' section on Old Lake Road. All agreed, except Joshua Sturgeon. Motion carried. Everhart Asphalt will pave Old Lake Road at an estimated cost of \$6,000.

Quality of Life Ordinance: Thomas Eberle motioned, Stacy Lesnett seconded, to adopt the quality-of-life ticket ordinance. All agreed, except Alan Watkins. Motion carried.

2026 Budget: A preliminary budget was presented to Council for review and changes for the November meeting.

Snow Blowers: Council requested additional quotes for the purchase of two snow blowers for the next meeting.

Water and Sewer Assistant Operator: Thomas Eberle motioned, Stacy Lesnett seconded, to hire John Zimmerman as the assistant water and sewer operator. All agreed except Joshua Sturgeon, who abstained. The motion carried.

Erie City Maintenance Agreement: Thomas Eberle motioned, Ginger Cinti seconded, to approve the maintenance agreement with the City of Erie. All agreed. Motioned carried.

Intermunicipal Police Service Agreement: Gregg Mitcho proposed to the Council a plan to provide police services to the borough. However, the Council determined that the current agreement as presented was unacceptable. They agreed that the two boroughs would need to collaborate and develop a regional or joint agreement before any formal agreement could be finalized.

Adjourned: Christopher Byers adjourned the meeting at 6:57 p.m.
