## Property Tax or Rent Rebate Program

The property tax/rent rebate - provides eligible seniors with rebates of up to \$1,000.00 on their annual rent or property tax bills. Pennsylvania residents age 65 and older, widows or widowers age 50 and older, or people with permanent disabilities qualify for the program if their annual household income does not exceed \$46,520 annually. (Exclude 50% of Social Security and Railroad Retirement, when calculating annual income.) Must be filed by June 30, 2025.

## Borough Bits

Burning is prohibited, with the exception of an outdoor recreational fire. Recreational fires can only burn clean, dry, and non-treated wood in a fire ring 2' or less in height and 4' in diameter.

If your dog barks in excess of ten (10) minutes, or intermittently for twenty (20) minutes, you may be fined. Pets are not permitted to run at large. Pet owners shall remove animal waste from public or private property immediately.

Residents are not permitted to blow grass clippings, leaves, or snow into the streets. You can be held responsible for causing a road hazard.

You can conveniently dispose of your household hazardous waste by calling 1-800-449-7587, or by visiting [www.wmatyourdoor.com](http://www.wmatyourdoor.com) for a collection appointment. This includes televisions, computers, and other electronics, etc.

Yards must be free of trash, garbage, junk and rubbish. Grass can not be higher than 9 inches.

All swimming pools with a depth of two feet or more shall be enclosed by a five foot fence. A building permit is required.

Abandoned or junk vehicles, can not be stored on the property.

**Only flush human waste and toilet paper down the toilet.**

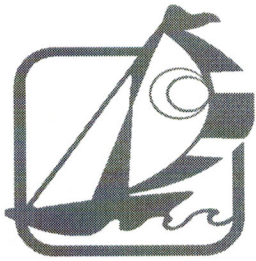
