The interest payment request came in from Andover Bank for Loan # 620000006 for \$6881.91 payable by 2-28-18 after that date it will be \$7081.91 will review the current account balance at PNC which is \$5359.88 as of 2-13-2018 with deductions of \$1155 and \$100 from this meeting and the automatic transfer to the Commonwealth of \$3205.60 which would provide a balance of \$899.28. A request was submitted today to the Borough for a deposit of funds to cover this interest cost; have not been provided an answer. We will have a deposit of \$55,000 as requested for a principal payment on

loan # 6200000001 and if no action is taken by the borough these funds will be used to pay the interest of \$6881.91 with the balance of \$48,118.09 going to the principal on the loan. A new Request for Lease Rental Payment for interest was submitted to the Borough on 2-14-2018 in the amount of \$6881.91 and will be deposited in the PNC account. Request to Lake City Borough for the interest on Loan 6200000001 for the amount of \$1491.26 due 2-28-18. Check # 1071 was written for payment.

Engineer Halmi: Contracts became effective the second week of January 2018. Konzel construction should be setting up there site office and getting underway in March 2018. Approvals have been underway all month with materials and equipment a monthly meeting with the contractor to discuss progress on the project. Technical NPDS permit for construction; Konzel is the co-permute are jointly responsible for the permit. (A resolution for the co-permitted for the NPDS permit - motion by Dave and second by Darwin). Additional discussion on the contract - sludge pump and the sludge press to handle 40 gallons per minute; would like to up size the pump to the capacity of the press. This would go from a 3" to 4" pump approx cost of \$5000 with a variable speed drive. Proposed Change #1 for the next meeting. Control building siding to change from the stucco finish to a metallic insulated siding possible some savings. Grit Drag out system a possible replacement with an in kind replacement or using air lift parts to remove the current system has a lot of maintenance hours and it freezes in the low temperatures, Halmi Engineering is still investaging alternate methods this is not part of the project funding most of this is a maintenance project. The last technical area is the office space for the plant operator and his testing; Steve will contact the code inspector and have additional discussions on this matter for the upgrades, Brent's input was in agreement to continue with this method of use being close to the equipment and controls. Look at local contractors to possibly refinish the office space. The use of camera's at the plant via remote. Pennvest the additional funding was approved for over a \$5,000,000.00 loan with a closing in April 2018. If required the authority a No Prejudice letter for the project by Engineer Halmi motion by Dave and second by Darwin.

Gary Bax; Resolution for official intent to reimburse both general funds and short-term borrowed funds used to construct improvements to the authority's wastewater treatment plant with funds received from the Pennsylvania infrastructure investment authority.

Motion for the Debit Obligation Resolution on Pennvest Loan No. 75327 in Section 3 the obligation is a current interest paying obligation. The obligation shall be dated as of its date of issuance. The Maximum principal amount of the Obligation is not to exceed \$5,063,240, which may be drawn and repaid on a non-revolving basis. The term of the obligation shall be an interest only period of up to 36 months followed by an amortization period of 240 months. The interest rate on the obligation shall be a fixed rate of (i) 1.00% per annum for interest only period, (ii) 1.00% per annum for the first 5 years of the amortization period, (iii) 1.742% per annum thereafter until maturity. Interest only on the outstanding principal balance of the Obligation shall be due and payable monthly during the interest only period. Level payments of principal and interest in the amount of (i) \$23,285.55 for the first 5 years of the amortization period, and (ii) \$24,577.36 thereafter until maturity, shall be due and payable on a

monthly basis. All outstanding principal and accrued interest shall be due in full at maturity. The Obligation shall be secured by, among other things, the Guaranty of the Borough.
